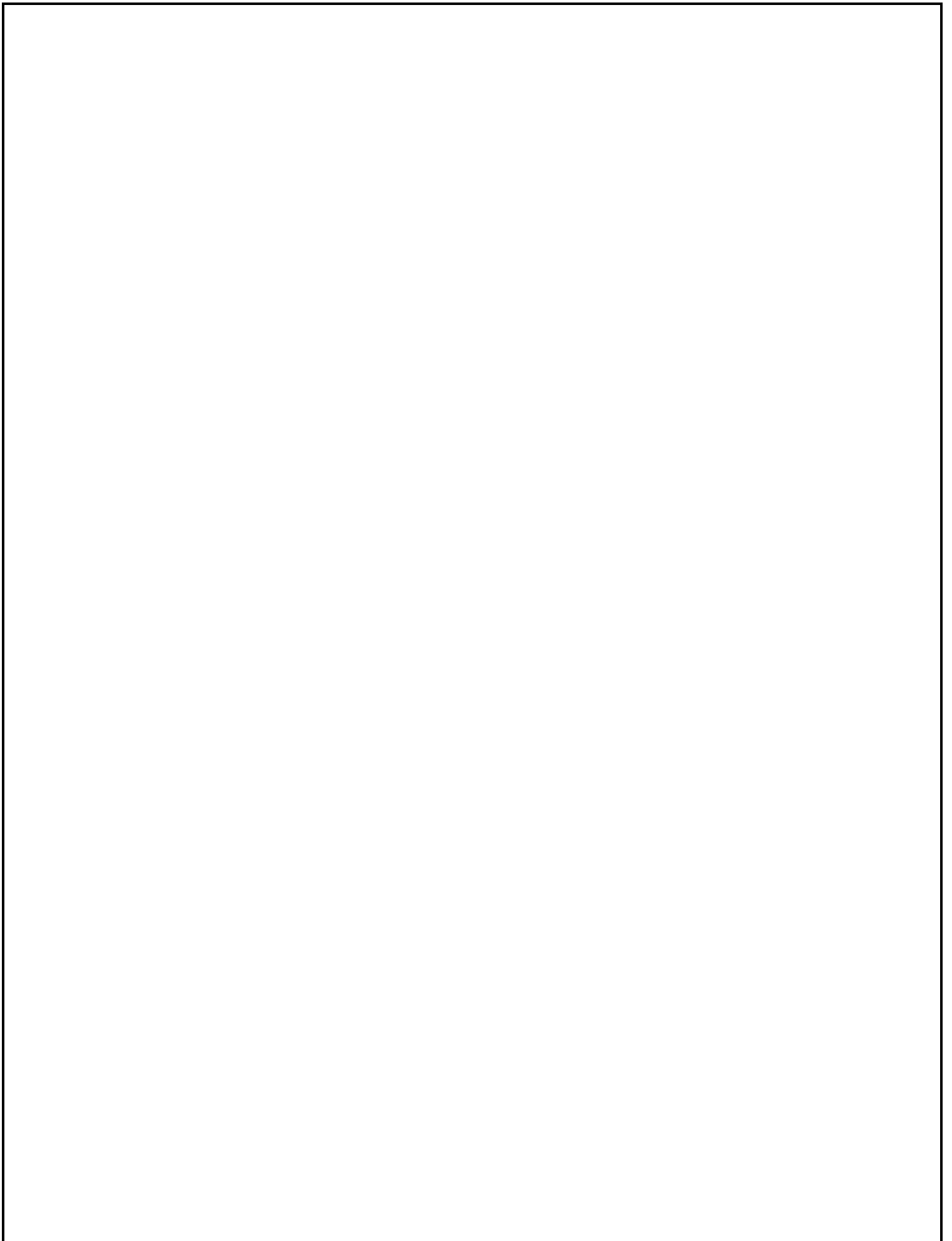
Human Rights Day: Worship and Garlanding Ceremony
